NEW VISA AND PERMIT CENTRES TO OPEN IN JUNE

The newly established Visa and Permit Centres will open in June across all 9 provinces. The Pretoria, Rustenburg and Kimberly centres will be the first to open on 2 June, followed by Durban, Bloemfontein and George on 9 June. The centre in Johannesburg will go live on the 18th, Cape Town on the 20th while Polokwane, Nelspruit and Port Elizabeth will start operating on 23 June.

The Department of Home Affairs has appointed VFS Global to establish the centres, receive and manage visa and permit applications in South Africa.
